<u>Autumn Term 2022-23</u>



Maths In Maths this term Year 5 will be focusing on Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division and starting a fractions unit. Fractions will be revisited later on in the year.	English In English we will be reading the book Boy at the Back of the Class by Onjali Q. Rauf in the first half term. We will be focusing on writing Recounts, a Formal Letter and a Diary Entry.
In maths this term Year 6 will be focusing on Place Value, the Four Operations (+, -, ×, ÷), Fractions and how to Convert Units.	In the second half term, we will be reading Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo. We will be writing a Character Description, a Newspaper Article and a Biography. Once we have finished this, we will complete a Kennings Poem.
Science In Science this term we are focusing on Forces in the first half term and then Properties of Materials in the second half term.	Religious EducationIn class 3 this term we will be focusing on the topics of:-Ourselves-Life Choices-Judaism-Hope
Geography & History In the first half term, we are learning about Settlements in Geography and then in the second half term we will swap to History, to learn about Anglo Saxons in the local area.	<u>Physical Education</u> This first term, we will be working on Tag Rugby, Swimming lessons and an Athletics Distance Challenge. In the second half term, we will begin our Acrobatic Gymnastics and a Dance Unit.
<u>Computing</u> The Computing units we will be working on are E- Safety, Computer networks and Programming within the app Scratch.	Spanish In Spanish we will begin learning Greetings.

Key messages and Homework

Homework will be sent out every Thursday, with the expectation that they will be returned to school on the following Tuesday. Children will receive Maths, Spelling and English based homework every week. Children should also access TT Rockstars, Spelling Shed and Lexia (where applicable) as part of their homework.

Children should read 3 times a week at home, if possible, with each time being recorded in their reading record books. They are to be sent home and returned alongside homework books.

Class 3 PE days for the first half term are Monday and Fridays. Students are to only wear PE kit on Mondays as Fridays are Swimming days. They will need to be in school uniform with their swimming kit in a bag.
